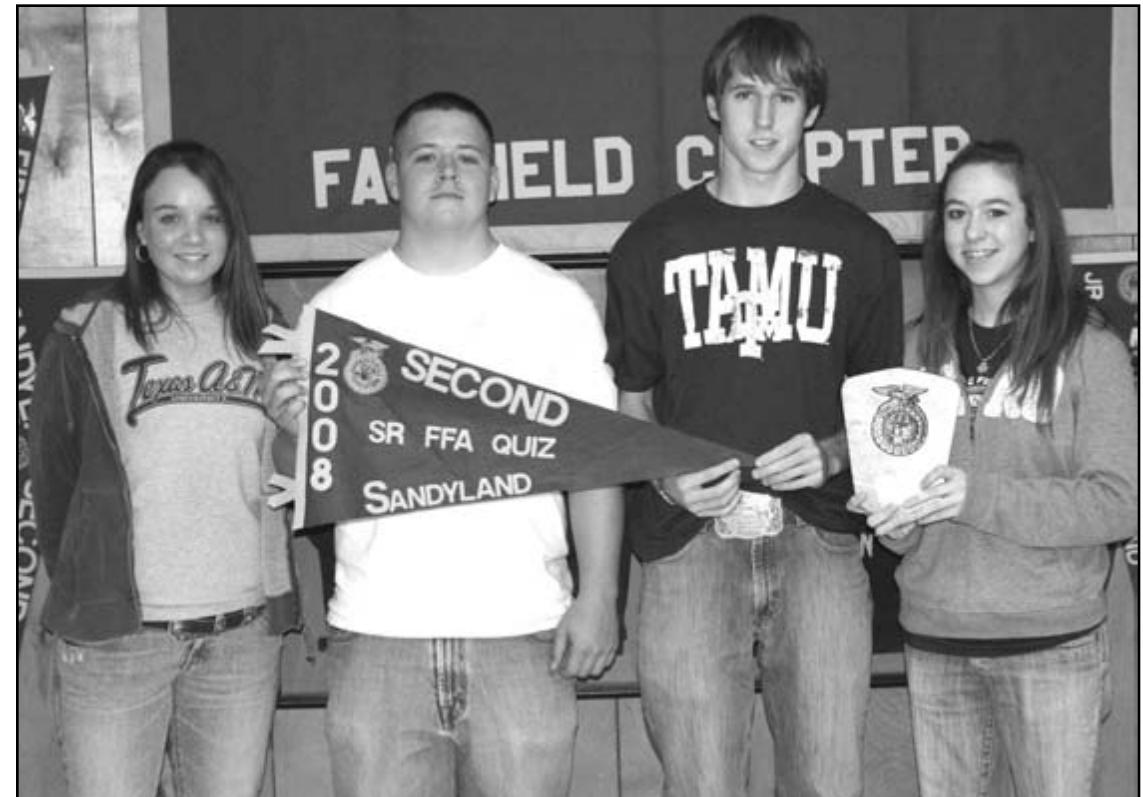

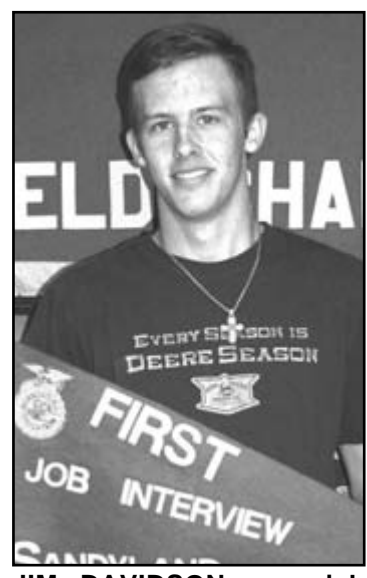
Individual contests at the district lever were won by Jim Davidson in job interview and Taylor Edwards-Adcock in senior creed speaking.
