NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT TO COMPLY WITH THE SUBDIVISION AND SERVICE EXTENSION POLICY OF C. H. WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION

Pursuant to Chapter 13.2502 of the Texas Water Code, C. H. Water Supply Corporation, herein known as The Corporation, hereby gives notice that any person who subdivides land by dividing any lot, tract, or parcel of land within the service area of The Corporation, Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 11629 in Freestone County, into two or more lots or sites for the purpose of sale or development, whether immediate or future, including sub-division of land for which a plat has been filed and recorded or requests more than two water connections on a single contiguous tract of land must comply with the Developer, Subdivision, and Non-standard Requirement Policy contained in The Corporation's tariff, Section F.

C. H. Water Supply Corporation is not required to extend retail water service to a service applicant in a subdivision where the developer of the subdivision has failed to comply with the Developer, Subdivision, and Non-Standard Requirement Policy.

Applicable element of the Developer, Subdivision, and Non-Standard Requirement Policy include:

- Evaluation by C H Water Supply Corporation of the impact a proposed subdivision service extension will make on The Corporation's water supply system and payment of the costs of this evaluation;
- Payment of reasonable costs or fees by the developer for providing water supply service capacity;
- Payment of fees for reserving water supply capacity;
- Forfeiture of reserved water supply service capacity for failure to pay applicable fees;
- Payment of costs of any improvements to The Corporation's system that are necessary to provide the water service;
- Construction according to design approved by C H Water Supply Corporation and dedication by the developer of water facilities within the subdivision following inspection

C.H. Water Supply Corporation's tariff and a map showing The Corporation's service area may be reviewed at the office at 316 Freestone County Road 941, Teague, Texas. The tariff and service area map are also filed of record at The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality in Austin, Texas, and may be reviewed by contacting TCEQ, c/o Utility Rates and Services Section, Water Utilities Division, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711.

For 2010 count . . . Census jobs available

The U.S. Census Bureau is looking for area residents to fill temporary jobs in preparation for the 2010 census.

Some of the jobs require employees to use handheld computers to canvass neighborhoods and update address lists. Other positions will provide office support.

Many of the jobs will last eight to 10 weeks.

Depending on the position and location, pay will range from \$8 to \$19.25 per hour. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older and a U.S. citizen.

Those applying will also be required to take a basic aptitude test which emphasizes clerical skills, literacy, organization and the ability to interpret information.

Testing in Fairfield will be held on Thursdays at 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. at the Fairfield Conference Center and in Teague on Tuesdays at 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. at Workforce Solutions.
