# Shot clinic set at center

A shot clinic is set Oct. 15 at Fairfield Senior Center on North Bateman from 10 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

The Texas Department of State Health Services will provide adult, age 18 and older, flu vaccinations.

DSHS recommends the flu shot for people who are at risk of serious influenza or its complications, and for people who can spread influenza to those at high risk, including anyone 50 years of age or older;

Anyone who has long-term health problems, lung disease, asthma, kidney disease, muscle or nerve disorders, metabolic disease such as diabetes, anemia, or other blood disorders;

Anyone with a weakened immune system due to HIV/AIDS or other dis-

eases affecting the immune system, long-term treatment with drugs such as steroids, cancer treatment with x-rays or drugs;

Women who will be pregnant during influenza season;

Residents of nursing homes and other chronic care facilities, healthcare providers, family members or anyone else in close contact with people at risk, and household contacts and out of home caregivers of infants zero to five years of age.

Cost is: individual, flu, \$10 donation fee, pneumococcal, \$20 donation fee, Td or Tdap, \$10.
