with Landing Zone for Doctor Chopper, Mexia EMS working on the man, CPR in progress.

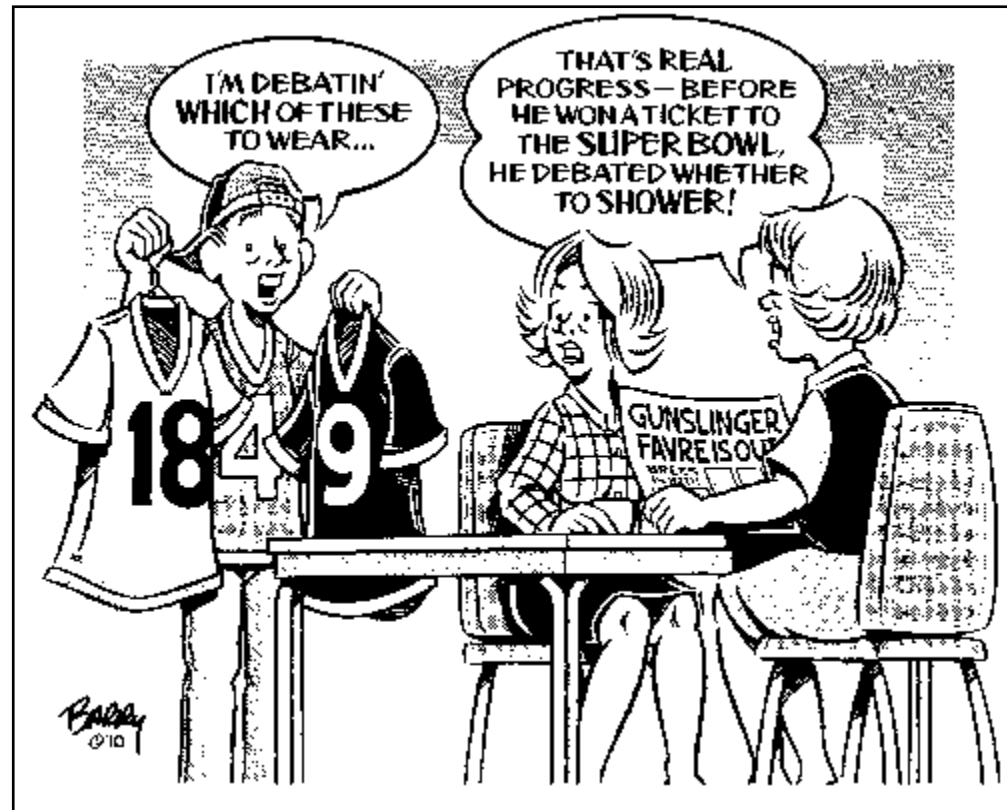

County sent her way....This emphasizes what I spoke of a few weeks back.....If at all possible, make 911 Calls from a land-line telephone....with a cell same calls skip out of your County. When this transpires you lose precious minutes in response time.

Teague and Donie VFD's to house on fire, FCR-751. Fairfield VFD to car on fire, Mile 197. Deputies McGowan and House to report of two men asleep in ditch, FCR-901. Both very drunk, within just a minute, both very arrested! Teague VFD and THDEMS to possible heart attack, West 84. Deputy Robert Elom to report of dog shot with birdshot. FEMS

and Streetman VFD to possible stroke, FCR-301. Deputy Harrison receives complaint from man on FM-833, his Ex-Girlfriend has called him over 200 times! Deputy Aultman to Dew, brick wall of truck stop sledgehammered, burglarized.

Burglar hits Dew business with sledge

Wielding a sledgehammer, a burglar gained entry to Dew Truck Stop last week to steal cash and cigarettes.

Entry to the building was gained by knocking a hole in a brick wall at the back of the store, Sheriff Ralph Billings reports.

The break-in occurred early Friday and was discovered by owner Bijavant Bhanot when he opened for business about 5:30 a.m.

Missing is \$900 in cash and \$110 in cigarettes, the sheriff says.

Billings also notes that similar break-ins have occurred recently at stores in Navarro, Limestone and Anderson counties.

The sheriff's department is investigating the burglary and working with law enforcement officers from the other counties.

Wortham ISD has two spots, place three held by Brent Jones and place four held by Scott Spencer, up for election this year.

The City of Wortham elects council members at-large and must elect members for seats currently held by Albert Hall, Cliff Nesmith and Frank A. McLellan.

Dew ISD holds its trustee election in November.

Early voting will be conducted April 26-May 4.
