

Host area teams at Fairfield Invitational . . .

FJHS eighth grade girls win track title

The Fairfield junior high school eighth grade Lady Eagles won their division and the seventh grade squad was third in the Fairfield Invitational track meet held at Eagle Field last week.

Eight area schools were represented in the meet.

FJHS eighth grade thin-

clads tallied 168 points to outpoint the competition, with Palestine Westwood scoring 134 points for second place and Mexia earning 128 for third.

In the seventh grade division, Westwood earned 148 points for first place, Teague tallied 137 for second and the Lady Eagles

scored 117 for third.

En route to winning the eighth grade meet, Fairfield won gold medals in four events.

Picking up two event wins was Megan Hodges, first in pole vault at six feet, six inches, and first in the 800-meter run in a time of 2:42.67 minutes.

FJHS swept the eighth grade 1,600-meter run—Peyton Pierce was first in 6:29; Jessie DeVries placed second in 6:32 and Miss Hodges took third in 6:46.

Claiming gold in the 100-meter hurdles was Karonesha Lowery, posting a time of 18.94 seconds.

The seventh grade team picked up a win in the 2,400-meter run when Sarie Hill completed the race in 9:56.

Held at Eagle Field . . . Seventh boys win meet

Fairfield junior high school seventh grade Eagles blasted the competition to win their division in the Fairfield Invitational track meet last week and the eighth grade placed second in its division.

The meet was run Thursday at Eagle Field and included athletes from eight area schools.

Eagles seventh grade thinclads amassed 213 points for the team win, Athens placed second with 135 and Palestine Westwood earned 104 for third.

The eighth grade division was won by Athens, 142 points, Fairfield was second with 124 and Westwood earned 123.5 for third.

On their way to the team victory, the seventh grade Eagles won six events.

Claiming first in two events was Raheem Hayes, posting a time of 8:56 minutes in the 2,400 run and covering 27 feet, seven inches in the triple jump.

Winning two gold medals in pole vault, with an effort of 9-0, and in long jump covering 15-1, was Chance Carroll.

The 800-meter run went to Cam Adams in a time of 2:37.02.

Hoisting the shot put 34-3.5 for first place was Dedrick Garner.

Fairfield eighth grade thinclads won gold medals in four events.

Picking up a pair of individual first was Larry Rose, with a time of 55.41 in the 400-meter dash and a height of 5-2 in high jump.

Rose also ran with Cade Warren, Danny Cockerell and Keil Meredith to win the 1,600 relay in a time of 4:00.

Pole vaulter Coy Pierce cleared 8-0 to win the event.
