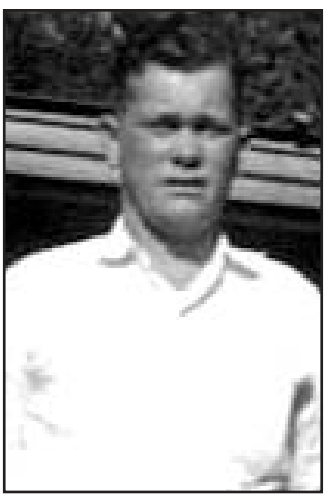
Eagles, Panthers, Goats Tie For Lead In District
